BIG WHITE, BRITISH COLUMBIA, MARCH 21ST TO 28TH

The trip so many of us have been waiting for is just around the corner! 56 SLO Skiers are traveling to Canada to experience the renowned powder snow. Truth be told, any kind of snow will be welcome. The majority of us will be flying from San Francisco straight into Kelowna. A bus has been arranged to take us to San Francisco. If you haven't received an email regarding the bus, contact Lauren asap! The town of Kelowna is 35 miles from the ski resort.

Before each week long trip we have an informational get together. Allan and Lori Margulieux have graciously agreed to have the party at their lovely estate. The date is March 14. The 5:00PM meeting will be followed by dinner and social hour. Again, if you haven't received the details via email, contact Lauren. People who miss the pre-trip party **miss soooo many important details**. The theme of this ski week is EASTER Parade. The ladies are wearing Easter bonnets at the Welcome and Farewell parties. There are two fun contests. First a silly and sexy sock contest..hmmm. Also a dry t-shirt contest with a funny and ski themed t-shirt winning semi valuable prizes.

We are staying at the Stonebridge Lodge in two bedroom, two bath luxury condos. The rooming lists will be available at the pre-trip party. If you didn't sign up in a foursome this is when you find out who you will be sharing a condo with. During the week there are two cooking contests. These contests are strictly **volunteer**. The gentlemen will show off their skill with delicious appetizers. The ladies will vie for the best dessert award. To make cooking easier for everyone there will be a grocery and liquor store stop on the way to the resort. Our condos are ski in and ski out. They are located a short walk from the beautiful European style village. The condo complex features an outdoor saltwater pool. Each unit has its own hot tub.

Now to the reason we go on ski trips...The ski resort is best known for its ghost trees and fluffy powder. A $\frac{1}{2}$ powder lesson is included in the package. Hopefully there will be powder snow. If not, a lesson is always a good idea. There are many different types of runs serviced by 16 lifts. Everyone will have plenty of skiing on their favorite types of runs. There are 118 designated runs. Of the runs 18% are beginner, 54% are intermediate, 22% expert, and 6% extreme. The elevation at the base area is 5,757 feet, and 7,606 feet at the summit. There are 38 acres of night skiing available.

Many thanks go out to Barbara and Paul Collins. They have done the accounting and numerous lists that keep our trips organized. Anyone who thinks running a ski trip is easy, should talk to the Collins! They also helped pick out the beautiful accommodations you will be enjoying. Sharon Page has arranged several non ski activities including wine tasting in the Okanagan Valley. Thanks to her skill as treasurer we were able to take full advantage of the currency exchange rate. Far West Mini Ski Week 2015: This trip to *Whitefish Mountain Resort* , March 30 - April 4, 2015, includes 3-4 days of skiing, lodging at Grouse Mountain Lodge, both Welcome and Farewell Parties, and optional activities such as snowmobile tours, day spa, Glacier Park tours, dogsled adventures, sleigh rides, and more. Far West International Trip 2015: We are still looking for people for our *Val d'Isere* trip in 2015. This International Ski Trip comes with a pre-trip to Paris , March 10-14, the main trip March 14-21, and a post-trip to Provence and the French Riviera March 21-28, 2015. Meetup Tune-up

Several club members have expressed concern about receiving Snowmail's through Meetup. There can be a number of reasons why this is occurring. The first thing one should do is double check the email address you are using for your Meetup account. Make sure it is the email you want to use to receive your Snowmails, and make sure you didn't make a typo when you entered the email address. (It's amazing what we learn by doing...incorrectly!)


If all of that looks good, it may be that you have set your email settings in such a way that Meetup thinks you don't want to be bothered with emails (Snowmails) from Meetup. Here's how you can check this out:


Once you are on the SLO Skiers Meetup home page, click on 'My Profile' and go down to 'email & notifications'. You will find a long list of email settings. I check every box, as these only apply to SLO Skiers emails, not all of Meetup. You can leave out things like 'member suggests a Meetup' or 'my Facebook friend joins the group', but don't leave anything out that talks about being notified of, or reminded of, a Meetup.

If you have tried all of this, and you still do not receive your Snowmails, contact Fran: fancat87@gmail.com. I will personally sit with you, and we will figure out the problem.

By the Wednesday meeting, you should receive a Snowmail with a link to your newsletter and reminder about the meeting. If you do not receive this Snowmail, first check to see if it is going in your spam or bulk mail file, then try the above solutions.


